



## Langley Baseball Association Volunteer Commitment Form

Langley Baseball is run 100% by volunteers. Parents and guardians of all players are required to help throughout the season to ensure that it runs smoothly.

As part of your child's commitment for the season, each family must submit this signed commitment form as well as their credit card information or a deposit cheque (made payable to Langley Baseball Association and post dated to June 30 of this year) in the amount of \$200.00.

Your Team Parent is responsible for assigning game duties and keeping track of volunteer time throughout the season. The team parent will submit completed volunteer time to the Volunteer Coordinator. If you are unable to complete a task for medical reasons, please ensure you advise your team parent who can set you up with alternate duties.

If at the conclusion of the season they have deemed that a player's parent or guardian has not fulfilled their volunteer commitment, the credit card will be charged or the deposit cheque will be cashed. What are some volunteer duties available?

### **Pre-Season and During the Season:**

#### **Field Maintenance:**

- Field maintenance is essential to keep our fields to the high standard our players deserve. It involves moderate and physical maintenance work like shoveling, weeding, pressure washing, painting, raking etc.
- Please keep an eye out in your email as the Volunteer Coordinator periodically emails out available opportunities for field maintenance.

#### **Maintenance Work:**

Parents and families who have specialized skills are needed from time to time for maintenance work and things around the park. This could include electrical work, drywall work, cleaning, etc.

### **During the Season:**

#### **Scorekeeping:**

Each team is responsible for their own scorekeeping in the 7+ divisions. This is a great way to help and get in your volunteer hours. Scorekeeping in baseball is a bit more involved than other sports and has a bit more of a learning curve. Please visit our website for tutorials that are available under the tab – Volunteer Opportunities.

#### **Concession Duties:**

It has been the responsibility of the home team at a game, to provide 2 adults to run their side of the concession for the duration of the game. This includes managing the sales of concession items, opening and closing the concession.

**Tournaments and Post Season:**

Tournaments at Langley Baseball cannot run smoothly without the help of volunteers. If you are interested in helping during our tournaments, this is a great opportunity to get in your volunteer hours. Duties would include announcing names of players and teams, helping with concession, field duties such as set up and taken down, scorekeeping and pitch count.

**Photo Day:**

We are always in need of parents/family members to help ensure our photo day runs smoothly and efficiently. Duties would include checking in teams and players as they arrive and guiding them to where their team is meeting prior to photos.

**Cancellation Policies:**

Volunteers **MUST** provide a minimum of **24 hours cancellation notice** once signed up for a volunteer activity.

If you need to cancel your volunteer assignment, please remove your name from the sign-up website and advise the Volunteer Coordinator immediately.

Rain outs are out of our control and our Volunteer Coordinator will do everything they can to advise you as soon as possible. Please be sure to follow Langley Baseball on social media as rain outs are posted there. Occasionally the rain outs are close to, or during games and the Volunteer Coordinator isn't able to provide proper notice. We realize this can be inconvenient for all volunteers including scheduled coaches. We rely on volunteers, therefore if your volunteer hours get cancelled due to weather, you will be credited for the hours worked and the remaining will be rescheduled.

Please complete the player information and credit card information (if you chose that option) form and return it to your team parent at the start of the season. If you want to submit a post-dated cheque – please complete the attached form with cheque and provide it to your team parent.
